**PURPOSE:** The strategy helps students determine the text's structure (or text's organization). Students read a paragraph or short section of text. Then students read a longer passage and select the structure of the passage.

## **Strategy 1: Instructions for Determining Text Structure**

- 1. Use the *Text Structure Reflection (C.023.AMI) handout* with the cards from the *Text Structure Sort (C.022) handout*. Students practice sorting the short paragraphs according to the text structure in each paragraph.
- Following this practice, students apply their understanding of structure to authentic informational text. Choose a non-fiction, expository, informational text. Using the *Text Structure Reflection (C.023.AMI) handout* with the individual *Text Structure Graphic Organizers (C.023)*, students select the structure of the text. Students fill out the organizer.

**NOTE:** This is a difficult skill to learn. Selecting simple text for practice and then increasing the complexity of the text is often beneficial.
