PURPOSE: This strategy builds students' knowledge of vocabulary in a text by linking word meanings that students know with new words they may encounter.

Strategy 1 Instructions – Semantic Gradients

TEACHER PREPARATION

- 1. Select a key idea from the story.
- 2. Determine the various words, known words and new words, that are synonyms and antonyms of the key idea word (start with 8-10 words). REMEMBER to connect known ideas with various words related to these ideas.
- 3. Put each word on an index card.

WITH THE STUDENT

- 1. Teach the student the process of gradation. For instance, ask the student to put these words in order, from one extreme to the other: Hot, Cold, Warm, Icy
- 2. Have the student complete the same process with the list of generated words.
- 3. Student can add these words to a word study notebook (see sample).
- 4. Ask the student new related words.
