PURPOSE: This strategy helps students use the main ideas to write a summary.

Strategy 2 – Instructions for Writing a Summary

- After a student identifies the Main Ideas in a reading selection, the student can write a summary.
- Select a graphic organizer from the "Super Summary" handout.
- Fill in the main idea statements on the graphic organizer.
- Using these statements, write a summary paragraph including all of the main ideas.
- IMPORTANT: Help students merge repeating ideas and formulate a concise paragraph.
