ELIGIBILITY:

- NY High School Diploma or its equivalent.
- High School GPA or T.A.S.C. Score
GPA: 78+
T.A.S.C.: 2500+
- SAT and/or ACT (optional)
SAT: 800+
ACT: 16+
- One of the following criteria:
 - Student or an immediate family member have performed a minimum of 75 days of qualifying seasonal or temporary farm work in the past 2 years.
 - Applicant is/was eligible to receive services from TITLE 1-Migrant Education Programs.
- Eligibility can also be confirmed through documentation from Pathstones
