Key Abbreviations

- ECA = NYS-MEP Early Childhood Academic Tool
- NYS-MEP = New York State Migrant Education Program
- METS = Migrant Education Tutorial and Support Services program centers
- MPO = Measurable Program Outcome
- P3-P5 = The MEP turns the child's age into a grade level for the computer records, by putting the letter "P" in front of the child's age. "P3" refers to a preschooler that is 3 years old.

Key Abbreviations

- P3 = Grade used for 3-year-old preschool student
- P3-P5 = Grade/Age – range of Level 2, preschool students eligible to use the ECA with

- ELA = English Language Arts (reading, writing, listening, and speaking skills)
- ENL = English as a New Language

Who is a Candidate for the ECA

- Candidates for the ECA are those Preschool students ages (P3-P5) who are identified for instruction.

Tips to Make the ECA Easier

- What are the questions? What are the correct responses?
- It can take 2 or 3 sessions to give the ECA
- Reminder: Assessing not teaching during the ECA
- Administer the ECA just like activities in a regular lesson

Where to Record the ECA Results

- Record results for each student on their individual Student Response Sheets
 - Pretest
 - Posttest
- Give Data Specialists a copy so they can enter the scores into the system

How to Record Time Spent with a Preschooler

- Record your *instructional time* only as ELA, ENL, or Mathematics, in increments of ¼ hours.
- Record *the time spent on the ECA Pretest or Posttest* as ELA, ENL, or Mathematics, too.
- Support Services are recorded according to the service provided.
