



Eligibility for CAMP

1 First Year Applicant

- This means that the student applying to our program is entering University/College for the first time.
- GAP years are acceptable within reason

4 Seasonal Agricultural Work/ Temporary Farmer

- Students with a COE always qualify for application
- 75 days of seasonal farm work in the past 2 yrs., before graduation (farm letter)
 - Must be in agricultural work (picking fruits or vegetables, caring for animal, etc).

2 Financial Struggle

- The type of need can vary between the student stories, which can affect the amount/types of scholarships offered to students.

5 U.S. Citizen or Legal Resident

- This means any student that is a USA citizen, and have legal permanent residency.

3 Academic Assistance

- MINIMUM GPA 78%
- **Basic English Language Comprehension**
- While there is no maximum GPA, students with higher GPA just need to show an academic need
- SAT/ ACT are not required
