
Who can participate?

Must have a financial and
academic need

On track to graduate with a
high school diploma or
equivalent (GED)

Applicant is/was eligible to
receive services from Migrant
Education Programs.

Applicant or immediate family
member must have performed
a minimum of 75 days of
seasonal or temporary farm
work within the last 2 years
from graduation

Eligible if they have
documentation through
NFJP (Pathstone).
