Educators and Directors use the Academic Service Intensity Rubric (ASIR) with the needs assessment data collected to determine the individual Service Level for each student in program year 2023-24.

### **BOLST-Assessment Form & Score Sheet**

Educators use this tool to administer the Basic Oral Language Screening Tool (BOLST) and record student responses. The BOLST can be used virtually or in person for program year 2023-24.

### **BOLST-Listening & Pictures PowerPoint**

Educators can use these PowerPoint graphics and recorded questions to support the administration of the BOLST in person or virtually for program year 2023-24.

### **BOLST-Pictures Only**

Educators can use these pictures from the BOLST PowerPoint, in person, to support the administration of the BOLST in program year 2023-24.

**OSY Profile**

Educators use OSY Profile to collect additional needs assessment data for OSY students for program year 2023-24. Options: Educators can enter data on the WebApp, and METS can print individual copies from MIS2000.

**Personal Learning Plan-Fillable**

Educators use the Personal Learning Plan (PLP) to set and track short-term educational goals with Level 2 Out-of-School Youth. 2023-24 options: Educators can use this form to write or type responses and/or enter directly into WebApp.

**School Year-Mid-Year and Student Summary Form**

Educators use the Mid-Year form to update needs assessment information as needed throughout the 2023-24 program year. METS programs generally run personalized copies from MIS2000 with basic information prefilled for each student.

**School Year-Mid-Year and Student Summary Form-Guidance Document**

This chart highlights the required services by grade and service intensity level for the new Service Delivery Plan starting in program year 2023-24.

**School Year-Student Intake Form**

Educators use the Student Intake Form (SIF) to collect the initial needs assessment data about students for the 2023-24 program year, and as students arrive in a new school district throughout the program year. METS generally run personalized copies from MIS2000 with basic information prefilled for each student.

**School Year-Student Intake Form-Guidance Document**

This guidance document explains each data element collected on the Student Intake Form (SIF) for program year 2023-24.
